

Troubleshooting

Symptom	Try Some Stuff
No Picture	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make sure your TV is on and properly connected to the Switcher. 2. Check that the signal source is on and connected. 3. Verify your TV is set for 4K/HDR. 4. Check the system connection quality. 5. Check the cable quality. <p><i>"is your TV on? ... really ... we're using THAT???"</i></p>
Obscure Picture	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Disconnect then securely reconnect the cables. 2. Check the HDMI cable quality.
Trouble getting 4K/HDR Content	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make sure you are using an HDMI 2.0 (or above) cable! <i>Echogear just so happens to sell some!</i> 2. No HDR or Deep Color? Your TV's settings may need to be turned on for that HDMI input. The output device may not be HDR enabled either. 3. No signal at all? Make sure both devices are HDCP 2.2 compatible. If one is not, the signal may be blocked at one end of the connection.
Remote not working	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Verify the plastic film is removed from the battery. 2. Verify the path from remote control to IR repeater is not blocked. 3. Check the battery.
